BY VIRTUE OF HIS LEGITIMATELY ACQUIRED POWERS

In order to ensure the preservation of the moral heritage of the dynastic Orders of the House of Savoy and to guarantee the quality of those decorated in order to preserve them worthy of their glorious origins and many centuries of history

DECLARES THAT

1. the conferment of the Order of the Holy Annunciation is now suspended *sine die*;
2. all dynastic Orders are preserved according to the statutes in force at the death of H.M. King Umberto II and any subsequent modification not originating with the legitimate Head of the House must be considered null and void;
3. that he intends to unite all those invested and all those who wish to act in accordance with tradition in a specially formed Body in which those invested by HM the King will have the right to belong. Any matters concerning further dispositions regarding the Orders will appear in the schema drawn up by Prince Aimone of Savoy.
